Through the selection of different sessions, students are given the opportunity to explore specific areas of interest under the guidance of our outstanding staff.

Students will select from one of seven *Adventure Series* topics each week for the morning session. The afternoon activities are planned by the staff and correspond to weekly themes.

Adventure Series Topics

Cooking	This session enables children to experience the world of food first hand. They will learn how food is prepared as well as how food contributes to their health and well-being.
Science-Math-Nature	Children are naturally curious—always the “why” and the “how” of life. This session provides opportunities for children to actively explore their interests in a safe and fun atmosphere.
Arts & Crafts	As children draw, paint, and create collages, they experiment with color, line, shape, and size. Through this session, they will use different materials to try out new ideas, learn to plan and experiment.
Water Fun	Water is necessary for all living things. This session provides activities and exploration opportunities for students to learn about the value and importance of this valuable natural resource.
Drama-Dance-Literature	This session provides students with exposure of various topics such as music, movement, poetry and puppetry. Children will explore different types of dance and put on a one-act play.
Sports and Games	Children will be presented with techniques and skills in a variety of sports of interest. This session focuses on skill building, competing, cooperating and socializing.
Computer	Students are always interested in computer games and activities. This session will present children with the opportunity to participate in word-processing, graphic design, games and computer-based research.
